NOTICE OF PUBLIC REVIEW  
AND PUBLIC HEARING  
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

The City of Bowling Green proposes to amend the Annual Action Plans for Years 1 through 5 (Fiscal Years 2005 through 2009) for the Community Development Block Grant Program. The proposed amendments in Year 1, Year 2, and Year 3 are primarily housekeeping actions, based on the final spending in each activity. Recaptured funds in Year 4 and Year 5 are proposed to be reallocated to the Homeowner Occupied Housing Rehab Program. A total of \$48,699 will be reallocated to this Program. The Homeowner Occupied Housing Rehab Program was identified as a priority need in the 5 year Consolidated Plan and an amendment to that Plan will not be required.

The proposal constitutes a "Substantial Amendment" to the Annual Action Plans under the terms of the adopted Citizen Participation Plan, and requires a comment period and a public hearing. The proposed amendment is available for review on the City's website at [www.bgky.org](http://www.bgky.org) or at the Housing and Community Development Department in City Hall Annex, 1017 College Street, during regular business hours through September 15, 2009.

The City will hold a Public Hearing on September 1, 2009, at 7:00 PM Central Time at the City Commission Chambers, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor of City Hall, 1001 College Street, Bowling Green, KY.
