


## Keep It Clean!


Use the words from the list below to complete the tips on how each of us can help prevent stormwater pollution.






## Household Checklist


You can protect the environment by being aware of anything that could harm our water. With your parent(s), search your home and garage for the items listed below that could pollute our water.

Fold side to side and unfold.



Turn over and fold right and left points down to form roof.



3 Like this. Then turn over



**4** Bring the folded edges to meet the center fold allowing the side points underneath to pop out. Crease flat.



Fold the top point down as shown.



Fold the point to create a head.




Lift the bottom edge to meet the vertical center line.



Like this. Press flat and then fold outward as shown.



Repeat steps 7 and 8 wit the other foot.



10 Turn over.
