ORDINANCE AMENDING CODE OF ORDINANCES

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 19 (POLICE)
OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN CODE OF
ORDINANCES TO MAKE ADMINISTRATIVE
CHANGES

WHEREAS, the Crossing Guard Program operated through the Police Department has been under review for the past year; and,

WHEREAS, the City will be discussing transitioning this program to the school districts; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to amend language related to the part-time employment of crossing guards as seasonal employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Bowling Green, Kentucky as follows:

1. Chapter 19 (Police) is hereby amended as follows:

. . .

19-2 SCHOOL PATROL.

19-2.01 Created.

A school patrol, also referred to as crossing guard program, is hereby created and established to be known as the School Patrol.

19-2.02 Appointments.

The Chief of Police shall recommend to the City Manager appointments to the School Patrol. Members of the School Patrol shall be considered permanent part-time seasonal City employees.

19-2.03 Members Subject to Regulations.

Members of the School Patrol shall be subject to the personnel rules and regulations of the City and rules and regulations of the Police Department.

2. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and if any section,

phrase or provision shall for any reason be declared invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

3. All prior Municipal Orders or Ordinances or parts of any Municipal Order or Ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
