## MINUTES of SPECIAL WORK SESSION/STRATEGIC GOAL PLANNING of the BOARD of COMMISSIONERS of the CITY of BOWLING GREEN, KENTUCKY held JANUARY 25, 2019

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Bowling Green, Kentucky met in special session in the CrossWinds Boardroom at the Sloan Convention Center, Bowling Green, Kentucky at 8:00 a.m. on January 25, 2019. The special session was called to order and the following members were present: Commissioner Brian "Slim" Nash, Commissioner Sue Parrigin, Commissioner Dana Beasley-Brown and Mayor Bruce Wilkerson. - Review and update of Parks Capital Projects, including Preston Miller soccer fields, Parker Bennett outdoor court rehabilitation, Lampkin Park asphalt courts, CrossWinds golf carts and Shake Rag shelter;
- Background and overview related to planning and zoning;
- Proposal to adopt the Uniform Residential Landlord Tenant Act (URLTA);
- Considerations for affordable housing and ways to assist the homeless;
- Update related to the River Street Corridor Enhancement Plan;
- Future organization of the Convention Center Corporation;
- Review of streets and sidewalks policies and procedures;
- Request to pursue interests for an indoor pool;
- Proposed Fairness ordinance;
- Efforts to include public participation in decision making;
- Update related to the future of RiverView Golf Course;
- Develop modernized infrastructure;
- Updates related to downtown development, workforce development and transit coordination; and,
- Establishment of Fiscal Year 2020 strategic plan goals, top priorities, major projects and management agenda
