## ORDINANCE REZONING REAL ESTATE

ORDINANCE **PORTION** REZONING A ABANDONED CSX RAILROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM HI (HEAVY INDUSTRIAL) TO RM-3 (TOWNHOUSE/MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL) AND LI (LIGHT INDUSTRIAL) LOCATED ALONG BARRY STREET **BETWEEN VETERANS** MEMORIAL LANE AND NUGENT STREET PRESENTLY OWNED BY ST. JOSEPH CATHOLIC CHURCH OF BOWLING GREEN, INC.

WHEREAS, after proper notice and pursuant to applicable state statutes, the City-County Planning Commission of Warren County, Kentucky held a public hearing in City Hall on September 21, 2023 regarding the proposed rezoning of a portion of abandoned CSX railroad right-of-way located along Barry Street between Veterans Memorial Lane and Nugent Street, from HI (Heavy Industrial) to RM-3 (Townhouse/Multi-Family Residential) and LI (Light Industrial); and,

WHEREAS, said Planning Commission found the proposed zone change to be in agreement with the adopted Comprehensive Plan; and,

WHEREAS, said Planning Commission, thereafter and during the regular meeting, at said time and place with five (5) of the allotted eight (8) members of the Board present, voted unanimously to approve a recommendation to rezone a portion of abandoned CSX railroad right-of-way located along Barry Street between Veterans Memorial Lane and Nugent Street, from HI (Heavy Industrial) to RM-3 (Townhouse/Multi-Family Residential) and LI (Light Industrial).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Bowling Green, Kentucky as follows:

1. The portion of abandoned CSX railroad right-of-way presently owned by St. Joseph Catholic Church of Bowling Green, Inc. located along Barry Street between Veterans Memorial Lane and Nugent Street, which right-of-way is more particularly described on the attached maps and incorporated herein as if copied in full, is hereby rezoned from HI (Heavy Industrial) to RM-3 (Townhouse/Multi-Family

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Residential) and LI (Light Industrial).

2. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and if any section, phrase or provision shall for any reason be declared invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect

the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

3. All prior Municipal Orders or Ordinances or parts of any Municipal Order or Ordinance in

conflict therewith are hereby repealed.

4. This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to KRS 83A.060 in that it was introduced on

November 7, 2023, and given final reading on November 21, 2023, and said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon signature, recordation and publication in

summary pursuant to KRS Chapter 424.
