ORDINANCE RELATING TO CLASSIFICATION/PAY SCHEDULE

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CLASSIFICATION/PAY SCHEDULE "G" FOR GENERAL CLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021

WHEREAS, an Ordinance establishing the classification/pay schedule for classified employees is adopted each fiscal year to authorize the classifications and pay grades by which classified personnel are compensated; and,

WHEREAS, the Classification/Pay Schedule "G" for general/non-sworn personnel was last amended by Ordinance No. BG2020-25 effective September 15, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, City Manager Jeffery B. Meisel has recommended amending the schedule to move the position of Broadcast Specialist to pay grade 118; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to accept the recommendation of the City Manager and to amend the Classification/Pay Schedule for general/non-sworn personnel "General Schedule."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Bowling Green, Kentucky as follows:

- 1. The Classification/Pay Schedule for General Classified Employees, a copy of which is attached to and made a part of this Ordinance as if copied in full herein, is hereby amended for Fiscal Year 2021 to move the position of Broadcast Specialist to pay grade 118.
- 2. All prior Municipal Orders or Ordinances or parts of any Municipal Order or Ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
- 3. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and if any section, phrase or provision shall for any reason be declared invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.
