ORDINANCE AMENDING AGREEMENT RELATED TO THE CITY-COUNTY PLANNING
COMMISSION

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO
EXECUTE AMENDED AND RESTATED
AGREEMENT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF
THE JOINT CITY-COUNTY PLANNING
COMMISSION OF WARREN COUNTY AND
THE JOINT CITY-COUNTY BOARD OF
ADJUSTMENTS

WHEREAS, the cities of Bowling Green, Oakland, Plum Springs, Smiths Grove, Woodburn and the County of Warren, Kentucky, have in the past participated in a joint planning program to assist and promote the orderly development of their cities and county; and,

WHEREAS, the Kentucky Revised Statutes provide that the legislative bodies of incorporated cities and the Fiscal Court of the county containing those cities must enter and maintain in writing an agreement to form a joint planning unit; and,

WHEREAS, Warren County and the above named cities have previously approved and adopted an Amended and Restated Agreement for the Establishment of the Joint City-County Planning Commission of Warren County and the Joint City-County Board of Adjustments; and,

WHEREAS, amendments are necessary to the Agreement to provide for certain changes in the organization and administration of the joint planning unit, and the Board of Commissioners hereby determines that these changes are in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Bowling Green, Kentucky, as follows:

1. That the attached Amended and Restated Agreement for the Establishment of the Joint City-County Planning Commission of Warren County and the Joint City-County Board of Adjustments, a copy of which is attached and made a part of this Ordinance as if copied in full herein, is hereby approved.


2. The Mayor is authorized and directed to execute this Amended and Restated Agreement on behalf of the City.

3. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and if any section, phrase or provision shall for any reason be declared invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

4. All prior Municipal Orders or Ordinances or parts of any Municipal Order or Ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

5. This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to KRS 83A.060 in that it was introduced on April 20, 2021, and given final reading on May 4, 2021, and said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon signature, recordation and publication in summary pursuant to KRS Chapter 424.
