- 3. December 5 Downtown BGKY Lights Up 5-8pm. E Main side of Fountain Square closing 12-9pm. College between 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> closing 12-9pm. 7<sup>th</sup> between College and State closing 3-9pm. Light Fountain Square at 5:30pm. Light Circus Square and SKYPAC tree at 6pm. Fountain Square activities: window decorating contest and voting, live band on stage at State St. end, concession style food trucks on the park side of E Main, Ugly Sweater Crawl, photo booth. Circus Square has Santa's Village with post office, cookie decorating, visit with Santa, caroling flash mob, storytime at the splashpad, food trucks, DSSKY hot chocolate truck.
