ORDINANCE REZONING REAL ESTATE

ORDINANCE REZONING TRACTS OF LAND CONTAINING 1.267 ACRES FROM AG (AGRICULTURE) AND HB (HIGHWAY BUSINESS) TO HB (HIGHWAY BUSINESS) LOCATED AT 1110 AND A PORTION OF 1100 THREE SPRINGS ROAD PRESENTLY OWNED BY FLEA LAND, INC.

WHEREAS, after proper notice and pursuant to applicable state statutes, the City-County Planning Commission of Warren County, Kentucky held a public hearing in the Warren County Courthouse on December 21, 2023 regarding the proposed rezoning of tracts of land containing 1.267 acres located at 1110 and a portion of 1100 Three Springs Road, from AG (Agriculture) and HB (Highway Business) to HB (Highway Business); and,

WHEREAS, said Planning Commission found the proposed zone change to be in agreement with the adopted Comprehensive Plan; and,

WHEREAS, said Planning Commission, thereafter and during the regular meeting, at said time and place with six (6) of the allotted eight (8) members of the Board present, voted unanimously to approve a recommendation to rezone tracts of land containing 1.267 acres located at 1110 and a portion of 1100 Three Springs Road, from AG (Agriculture) and HB (Highway Business) to HB (Highway Business), with development plan conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Bowling Green, Kentucky as follows:

- 1. The tracts of real estate presently owned by Flea Land, Inc., containing 1.267 acres located at 1110 and a portion of 1100 Three Springs Road, which tracts of real estate are more particularly described on the attached maps and incorporated herein as if copied in full, are hereby rezoned from AG (Agriculture) and HB (Highway Business) to HB (Highway Business), with development plan conditions.
 - 2. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and if any section,

phrase or provision shall for any reason be declared invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

- 3. All prior Municipal Orders or Ordinances or parts of any Municipal Order or Ordinance in conflict therewith are hereby repealed.
- 4. This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to KRS 83A.060 in that it was introduced on <u>January</u>, 2024, and given final reading on <u>February</u>, 2024, and said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon signature, recordation and publication in summary pursuant to KRS Chapter 424.
