

MINUTES of SPECIAL WORK SESSION / FALL RETREAT
of the BOARD of COMMISSIONERS
of the CITY of BOWLING GREEN, KENTUCKY
held SEPTEMBER 16, 2019

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Bowling Green, Kentucky met in special session in the CrossWinds Boardroom at the Sloan Convention Center, Bowling Green, Kentucky at 12:30 p.m. on September 16, 2019. The meeting was called to order and the following members were present: Commissioner Dana Beasley-Brown, Commissioner Joe W. - Evaluation of Animal Control complaint process; and
- Review possibilities for development in the Shake Rag community.
