## ORDINANCE REZONING REAL ESTATE

ORDINANCE REZONING A TRACT OF LAND CONTAINING 1.16 ACRES FROM AG (AGRICULTURE) TO HI (HEAVY INDUSTRIAL) LOCATED AT 1171 FREEPORT ROAD, PRESENTLY OWNED BY THE INTER-MODAL TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY, INC.

WHEREAS, after proper notice and pursuant to applicable state statutes, the City-County Planning Commission of Warren County, Kentucky held a public hearing in City Hall on May 19, 2022 regarding the proposed rezoning of a tract of land containing 1.16 acres located at 1171 Freeport Road, from AG (Agriculture) to HI (Heavy Industrial); and,

WHEREAS, said Planning Commission found the proposed zone change to be in agreement with the adopted Comprehensive Plan; and,

WHEREAS, said Planning Commission, thereafter and during the regular meeting, at said time and place with six (6) of the allotted eight (8) members of the Board present, voted unanimously to approve a recommendation to rezone a tract of land containing 1.16 acres located at 1171 Freeport Road, from AG (Agriculture) to HI (Heavy Industrial), with development plan conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Bowling Green, Kentucky as follows:

- 1. The tract of real estate presently owned by the Inter-Modal Transportation Authority, Inc., containing 1.16 acres located at 1171 Freeport Road, which tract of real estate is more particularly described on the attached maps and incorporated herein as if copied in full, is hereby rezoned from AG (Agriculture) to HI (Heavy Industrial), with development plan conditions.
- 2. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and if any section, phrase or provision shall for any reason be declared invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.
  - 3. All prior Municipal Orders or Ordinances or parts of any Municipal Order or Ordinance in
