held JANUARY 28, 2022**


The Board of Commissioners of the City of Bowling Green, Kentucky met in special session in Meeting Rooms 1 and 2 at the Sloan Convention Center, Bowling Green, Kentucky at 8:00 a.m. on January 28, 2022. Mayor Todd Alcott called the meeting to order and the following members were present: Commissioner Melinda Hill, Commissioner Sue Parrigin, Commissioner Carlos Bailey, Commissioner Dana Beasley-Brown and Mayor Todd Alcott. Absent: None. There was a full quorum of the Board of Commissioners present.

The purpose of the special Work Session/Strategic Goal Planning was to discuss the 2022-2032 Strategic Plan prepared and facilitated by Kentucky League of Cities (KLC), as well as budgeting for the City of Bowling Green Fiscal Year 2022/2023, including American Rescue Plan Act (APRA) and tornado relief funding. The Strategic Plan consisted of eight (8) pillars for growth, management and implementation and included: efficient governance, downtown development, riverfront and greenway development, technology/fiber optic internet infrastructure, housing development, city workforce development, transportation and strong neighborhoods.
