Summary of Municipal Order No. 2018 -77 was read by the Acting City Clerk. Motion was made by Wilkerson and seconded unanimously by the City Commissioners for consideration of said Municipal Order. Mayor Wilkerson reviewed the history of when the City of Bowling Green moved to a City Manager form of government and acknowledged recently retired City Manager Kevin DeFebbo for his leadership. The Mayor further stated there were approximately 40 applicants reviewed for City Manager, both internal and external, and of those eight (8) were selected for interview. He thanked Interim City Manager Katie Schaller-Ward for stepping up to the role in the interim period and the Board of Commissioners for the insight and viewpoints during the selection process. He highlighted Jeff Meisel's background as he began his career with the City in January of 2002 as City Treasurer and was later promoted to Chief Financial Officer in 2006. Mayor Wilkerson also recognized some of Mr. Meisel's accomplishments and confirmed he and the Commissioners are confident in the choice of Jeff Meisel as City Manager.

Mr. Meisel thanked Interim City Manager Katie Schaller-Ward for her work as acting City Manager. He also thanked the Board of Commissioners for the opportunity to serve as City Manager and expressed appreciation for the City's management and staff. Mr. Meisel also noted Bowling Green is the fastest growing city in the State and he plans to fulfill the City's mission statement of providing Once the discussion ended, a roll call vote was taken. the best services at the lowest possible cost.
