## ORDINANCE CLOSING A PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY

ORDINANCE APPROVING THE CLOSING OF AN UNIMPROVED RIGHT-OF-WAY FORMERLY KNOWN AS MAIN STREET ROAD LOCATED BETWEEN THE INTERSECTION OF OLD BARREN RIVER ROAD AND VETERANS MEMORIAL LANE

WHEREAS, pursuant to applicable state statutes, the City-County Planning Commission of Warren County, Kentucky conducted a public hearing via video teleconference on May 6, 2021 regarding the closing of an unimproved right-of-way formerly known as Main Street Road located between the intersection of Old Barren River Road and Veterans Memorial Lane; and,

WHEREAS, with ten (10) members present and by unanimous vote, the City-County Planning Commission recommends the closing of 14,428 square feet (0.3312 acre) of an unimproved right-of-way formerly known as Main Street Road located between the intersection of Old Barren River Road and Veterans Memorial Lane, which is more particularly described on the attached map; and,

WHEREAS, the adjoining property owner has given written notarized consent, a copy of which is attached.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Bowling Green, Kentucky as follows:

- 1. The permanent closing of an unimproved right-of-way formerly known as Main Street Road located between the intersection of Old Barren River Road and Veterans Memorial Lane, which is more particularly described on the attached map and incorporated herein as if copied in full, is hereby approved.
  - 2. This ordinance shall be recorded in the Office of the Warren County Clerk.
  - 3. The property owner shall pay all costs incurred in the closing of the right-of-way.
- 4. All prior Municipal Orders or Ordinances or parts of any Municipal Order or Ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
