RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, _____ is 18 years of age or older on this date of application, and is not a relative of any on duty Firefighter, and has voluntarily elected to ride as a passenger (maximum of 8 hour shift, twice annually) in a Departmental vehicle of the City of Bowling Green Fire Department, Bowling Green, Kentucky, and to accompany fire officers of said city while engaged in the performance of their duties, to study and observe for his (her) own benefit the functions and operations of the Bowling Green Fire Department and its personnel; and

WHEREAS, _____ desires to do so at his (her) own risk and recognizing the possible and inherent danger to his/her person and property resulting therefrom; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bowling Green and the State of Kentucky does not wish to be liable for any damages arising from personal injuries and/or property damage sustained;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and other good and valuable consideration, the undersigneds do hereby, for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, and/or personal representatives:

1. Assume full responsibility for any personal injury or damage to the person or property of which may occur, directly, or indirectly, while in, on or about any such Fire Department vehicle, the Fire Department premises or any part thereof at the _____ Bowling Green Fire Department Headquarters building, Substation building, Training _____ facilities, or while accompanying any Fire officer of the City of Bowling Green while in _____ the performance of their duties.

2. Fully and forever release and discharge the City of Bowling Green and the State of Kentucky, its agents and employees, from any and all claims, demands, damages, rights of action, or causes of action, present or future, whether the same be known, anticipated or unanticipated, resulting from or arising out of _____ being in, on or about any such Fire Department vehicle, or at any or all of the premises and places aforesaid, or while accompanying any Fire Officer of the City of Bowling Green as aforesaid;

3. Indemnify and hold harmless the City of Bowling Green and the State of Kentucky, its agents and employees, for any acts or conduct of _____ of whatever kind or nature whatsoever, while in, on or about any such Fire Department vehicle, or at any or all of the premises and places aforesaid, or while accompanying any such Fire officer as aforesaid;

4. Agree to defend and to pay any costs or attorney's fees as a result of any action brought by or against the City of Bowling Green or the State of Kentucky, its agents and
