

- 1. Public Works' Melanie Shy was introduced to the group, as a contact for accessing City property for projects like sidewalks, streets, parking spots, etc. Melanie has worked with a few people in the room and wanted to make sure her contact details are shared with anyone who may have questions about access to City property Downtown when they're working on any construction, repairs, etc. She reported Household Hazardous Waste Day on April 20 and that the Nahm Building owner plans to work on repairs to its exterior brick soon. - 2. The City owns the Paxton and State St. parking lots in Downtown, and is offering parking spot leases to Downtown businesses as a means to offer employee parking during weekday business hours. A new digital leasing form has been built and ready for use. It's taken a year to develop, is featured on the City website's Downtown Development section, and includes all details and new dashboards showing what spots are reserved/how many are available/etc.
- 3. New free public parking signage is up across all government agency owned and managed lots in the Downtown area.
- 4. Updated Downtown Public Parking Map and Fountain Square Shop & Dine Guide are in the works.
- 5. Fountain Row Night at BG Hot Rods is Thursday, May 30. All Downtown businesses are welcome to participate they can reserve up to 8 free tickets for the game entry. They can also reserve a free table with 2 chairs for the concourse, to set up and promote their businesses. Sign up and claim tickets and a concourse table here by May 16, first come, first serve.
- 6. **Duncan Hines Days: June 3-9 Road Map & Menu** the website got a facelift with new photography, the road map is at the end of this agenda. Do you know a business that would be a good sponsor fit? Sponsorships begin at \$1,000 and the full list of sponsor packages is also at the end of this agenda.

- 7.**GM's Downtown Grant donation for \$50,000 in placemaking/placebranding is continuing** we are working with General Motors to be stewards of their dollars, Public Works to take most of the lead on this project because most of it involves traffic/road safety.
- 8. Parking structure projecting signage designs with "Park Free" and "Dine Here" are set to be voted upon April 25 at the TIF Authority board meeting.
- 9. Fountain Row new decorative sign posts order is complete. Public Works is setting order to install.
