In addition to informing you about common code violations in the city that may affect your home and property values, we hope you will take this opportunity to participate in improving your neighborhood!

FREE SERVICES FOR A CLEANER COMMUNITY

The City of Bowling Green, in cooperation with Goodwill's Another Way program, Warren County Solid Waste, and Scott Waste Services will provide the following **free services** from **September 2nd** to **September 5th**:

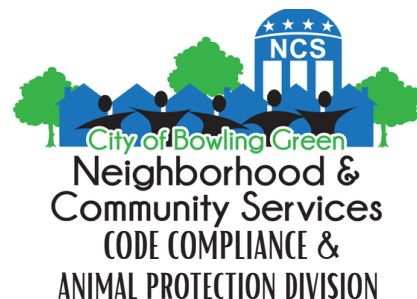
- Any rubbish, trash, yard debris, tires, appliances, junk, scrap, furniture or other nuisance items placed at the curb will be disposed of at no cost.
- If requested, *Another Way* staff will provide assistance in moving items to the curb for disposal, transport of items for donation, and light yard work at no cost.
- City staff will place address numbers on a house if requested at no cost.
- Junk vehicles will be towed off at no cost.
- Small accessory structures (sheds, old fences, etc.) will be demolished/removed at no cost.

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SCHEDULE SERVICES

- There is no need to contact us for free disposal of items placed at the curb during service week. Just place your items at the street, and we will take care of the rest!

COMMON CODE CONCERNS

- *City Code Officials will inspect the neighborhood the following week, after the free services are provided.*
- If code violations are observed, a Compliance Notice may be sent requiring correction.
- Take a moment to check your property for the common violations below.

NUISANCES:

- Ensure grasses and weeds are mowed and maintained below 10" tall.
- Eliminate outdoor accumulation or storage of the following items: Junk, scrap metal, construction, demolition, landscaping debris, waste materials, scattered or accumulated trash or rubbish.
- Unused tires cannot be stored outdoors, and Scott Waste will not collect them. We will collect tires during the free service week if placed separately at the curb.
- Remove any indoor furniture used or stored at an outdoor location.
- Check for, and remove, any sources of standing or stagnant water.
- Please bring all trash containers back to your house or apartment after collection day; they should be within 5 feet of the house.

MOTOR VEHICLES:

- Ensure all vehicles park on an improved parking surface, not on grass, dirt or mud.
- Trailers can be parked in side or back yards, but cannot be parked on front yards.
- Vehicles must be licensed and operable (drivable). Junk cars cannot be kept or stored outside.
- Vehicles cannot be in a state of major disrepair, disassembly, undergoing paint or bodywork, etc. unless stored indoors.
- Vehicles should not have flat tires or be on jacks, and must properly display a valid license plate.

STRUCTURES:

- The exterior of all structures should be maintained in good repair, structurally sound and sanitary.
- All exterior surfaces should be free of holes, peeling/flaking paint and broken windows.
- Address numbers shall be plainly legible and visible from the street. Numbers shall be a minimum of 3 inches tall.
- All accessory structures, including detached garages, sheds, fences and walls, shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair.
- Make sure gutters are cleaned out, free of obstructions, properly attached to the house.
